

Program Outcomes

The Career Academy

The Career Academy is an intensive 60-hour training designed to prepare people for the world of work. This intensive training is designed to build self-efficacy and confidence in job-seekers that otherwise would feel hopeless in their job search, but also allow them to prove their worth through the hard work that the training demands. Because Blue Jacket accepts every adult into their doors who possesses some barrier to employment, the screening tool is personal motivation. An inability to graduate the simulated workplace environment in the training exhibits an inability to hold down a job.

Years ago, we found that hiring Job Developers through governmental grants puts the relationship at risk with the employer if the grant is no longer funded. This full-service staffing enterprise allows an employer that is willing to give second chances a low-risk, employment trial of Career Academy graduates.

This business-professional thrift store was born out of a need to keep our clothing bank alive through a paid employee to outfit students in the Career Academy with donated clothes that we in turn give to


them for free. It is home to one of the highest quality thrift stores in the region – you have to see it to believe it.
